This is a leadership role with responsibility for one or more speciality areas of medical physics practice. We welcome international applications and offer a relocation package.

The radiation oncology service is part of an integrated cancer centre. We operate Varian systems including 3 Truebeam linacs, Bravos HDR brachytherapy and Aria/Eclipse software plus a Siemens CT scanner and Xstrahl superficial x-ray system. A full range of contemporary external beam radiation treatments are offered, as well as image guided HDR brachytherapy for gynaecological, prostate and skin cancers.

Our friendly physics team of 13 people is focused on excellence in clinical care, and we aim to publish and present our work where possible. We are also an ACPSEM accredited training centre with a good reputation for training medical physicists.
